"ANJALI'S TRIUMPH: A JOURNEY FROM SILENCE TO SUCCESS"



Anjali (name changed) was around five years old when she first visited the Child Guidance Clinic at Antara with her mother. She was experiencing speech difficulties and social aloofness, and her school had recommended special education for her. A leading psychiatrist in Kolkata diagnosed her with Autism Spectrum Disorder.



Feeling utterly helpless, her parents her father, a scientist, and her mother, a homemaker turned to Antara for support. They were clear about their preference for non-pharmacological interventions. Following her registration, psychiatric social worker Mr. Nitai Chand Mukherjee initiated weekly play therapy sessions. By the 16th session, Anjali showed remarkable progress, her speech became clearer, and she overcame her social withdrawal and clumsiness.
